Poulsbo, WA, April 4-5, 2009

## Notice of Race

### Rules

The Racing Rules of Sailing, the ISSA Procedural Rules and the Sailing Instructions will govern the regatta.

### Entry

Open to all registered high school teams. There is no entry fee.  
An adult coach or chaperone must accompany teams.

### Format

A mix of fleet and team racing is planned with emphasis on learning and enjoying team racing. Coaching and debriefs will be led by experienced college sailors and team racing coaches.

### Boats

The regatta will be sailed in FJ's and Vanguard 15's.

### Location

The Port of Poulsbo, at the corner of Hostmark and Front Streets in downtown Poulsbo. Rigging on C Dock, rotations on F Dock with viewing from Waterfront Park.

### Meals

A \$15 meal package is available. This includes Saturday lunch and dinner, Sunday breakfast, lunch and post race snack. Saturday dinner will be in the Park following racing and Sunday breakfast will be served at the billet in the Masonic Lodge. If you desire there are many restaurants within easy walking distance in downtown Poulsbo.

### Facilities

There are bathrooms and showers in Waterfront Park. Lunches will be available in the Pavilion on shore or on the rotation dock between races. Free billeting is provided Saturday night in the Masonic Lodge across the street from the docks. Bring a sleeping bag and pad
