NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 2009-2012 ISAF Racing Rules, the prescriptions of US SAILING, this Notice of Race, the 2009-2012 ISSA Procedural Rules, and by the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY

2.1 This regatta is open to all High School Teams.

4. ENTRY AND COMMUNICATIONS

5. ENTRY FEE

5.1 The entry fee is \$5 per competitor, which may be paid on regatta day. Fee will include lunch and a travel snack. Checks to Kitsap Sailing & Rowing Foundation.

6. BOATS

6.1 Vanguard 15s and FJs are provided.

6.2 Junior Varsity racing boats and venue will be announced upon allocation of boats for varsity teams.

6.3 The event will be sailed in V15s and FJs thanks to the generosity of Port Townsend, Bainbridge, and North Kitsap who are loaning their boats. We ask you treat the boats, equipment and all facilities with the utmost of respect. Flagrant abuse can result in a score penalty to your team.

9. RACING AREA

9.1 The racing area will be the waters directly south of the Waterfront Park dock.

9.2 Team members, coaches and spectators will be able to watch the racing from the dock.

10. COURSES

10.1 Based on weather conditions, the Race Committee will determine the courses. Short collegiate style courses will be used.

11. FORMAT

11.1 The format will consist of two races in A Division, and two races in B Division.

12. SCORING

12.1 The regatta will be scored using ISSA Procedural rules.

15. COACHING

15.1 Unless it is with the permission of the Race Committee, coaches and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the racing area.

15.2 Competitors may receive coaching including instructions, assistance, equipment or sustenance while on the dock.

18.OFFICIAL NOTICE FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS:

No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, distilled spirits), or use any controlled substance (marijuana, cocaine, etc.), the possession of which is unlawful. An alleged breach of this rule and/or other disciplinary matters that occur on March 27-28-29 may be the basis for a hearing under rule 69.1. The protest committee for such a hearing will be the Regatta Chairperson, a member of the NWISA Board of Directors and the chairperson of the protest committee.
